If you disagree with this determination, you may request an appeal by submitting a written request to the Forest Appeals Commission at

Victoria, British Columbia V8W 9V1
The appeal request must be signed by you, or on your behalf, and must contain:

- a. your name and address; **AND** the name of the person, if any, making the request on your behalf;
- b. the address for serving a document to you;
- c. the grounds for appeal; and
- d. a statement of the relief requested.

The appeal must be received by the Forest Appeals Commission **no later than three weeks** after the date this notice of determination is delivered to you.

If you have new information that was not available at the time I made this determination, you may request a review of my determination on this new information. A request for such review must be in writing, must be signed by you, or on your behalf, and must contain:

- a. your name and address; **AND** the name of the person, if any, making the request on your behalf;
- b. the address for serving a document to you or the person acting on your behalf;
- c. the new evidence that was not available at the time this determination was made; and
- d. a statement of the relief requested.
